Safe Harbor

are granted safe harbor and meet AYP under Safe Harbor. Standard for other indicators (graduation rate for high schools, attendance rates for other buildings and corporation {2000-2001 and 2001-2002}) is 95 percent. Safe Harbor under other indicators is granted if a school/corporation meets 95 percent or shows improvement.

## Participation

NCLB requires 95 percent participation in testing. The number of students tested (including those taken out for not meeting full academic year) is compared to your PE-form enrollment data submitted to the STN site from October 1.
